



According to an article 'India's "Untouchable" Face Violence and Discrimination' published by the reporter of National Geographic Channel 'Hillary Mayell' on 3rd June 2003, More than 160 million people in India are considered "Untouchable"—people tainted by their birth into a caste system that deems them impure, less than human. Human rights abuses against these people, known as Dalits, are legion. A random sampling of headlines in mainstream Indian newspapers tells their story: "Dalit boy beaten to death for plucking flowers"; "Dalit tortured by cops for three days"; "Dalit 'witch' paraded naked in Bihar"; "Dalit killed in lock-up at Kurnool"; "7 Dalits burnt alive in caste clash"; "5 Dalits lynched in Haryana"; "Dalit woman gang-raped, paraded naked"; "Police egged on mob to lynch Dalits".

India's Untouchables are relegated to the lowest jobs, and live in constant fear of being publicly humiliated, paraded naked, beaten, and raped with impunity by upper-caste Hindus seeking to keep them in their place. Merely walking through an upper-caste neighborhood is a lifethreatening offense. Nearly 90 percent of all the poor Indians and 95 percent of all the illiterate Indians are Dalits, according to figures presented at the International Dalit Conference that took place May 16 to 18 in Vancouver, Canada.

Therefore it is necessary to make the students and staff aware of the caste based discrimination and violence various ways to avoid as well as legal provisions available in our country for gaining justice.

- The persons (population) affected by it.
- Who are untouchables.
- What kind of unwanted events taken place on Dalits in India in the past.
- What is the quality of living of Dalits in India
- What the statistics compiled by 'India's National Crime records Bureau' indicating about the crimes committed in Dalits.
- What was the reaction of police, villege councils and Government officials on this issue

What are the possible ways to overcome cast based violence and discrimination in India.
