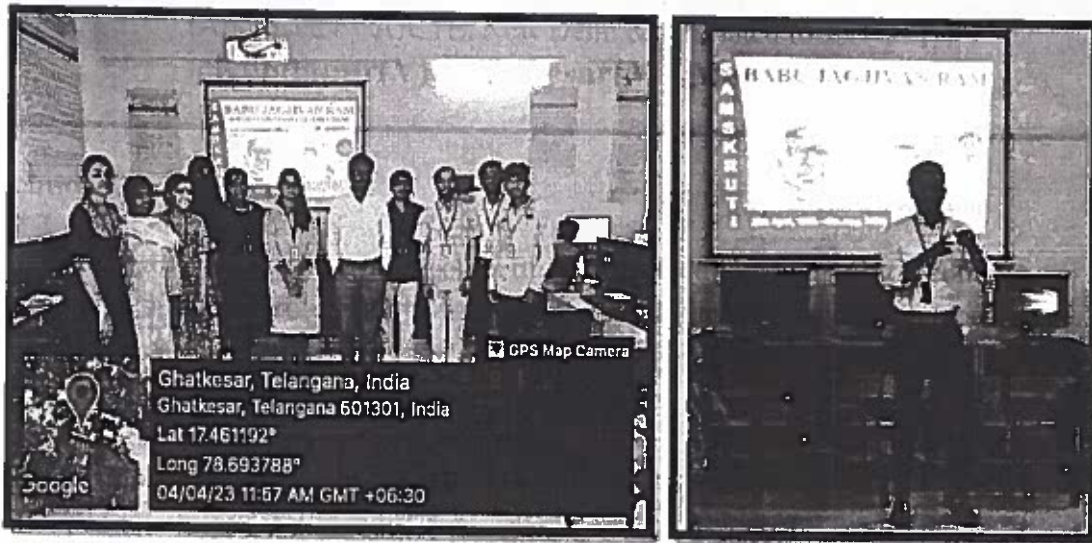



Fig: Student participation in Elocution Competition

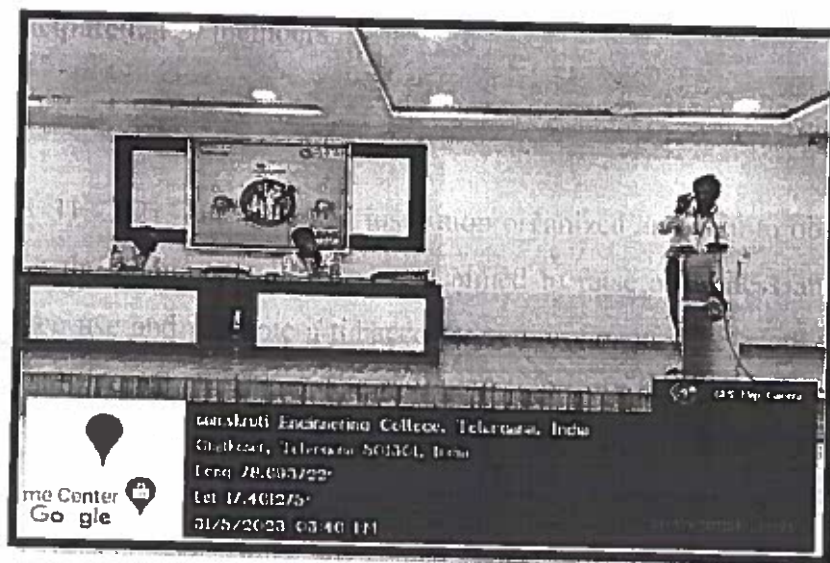

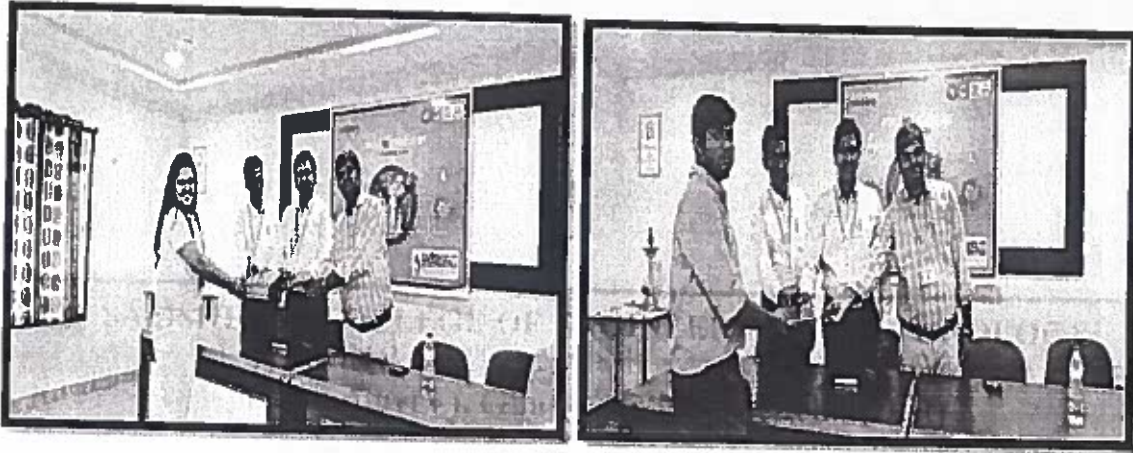


Fig: Prize Distribution: 1st prize was awarded to Ch Kavya & 2nd prize Shashivardhan

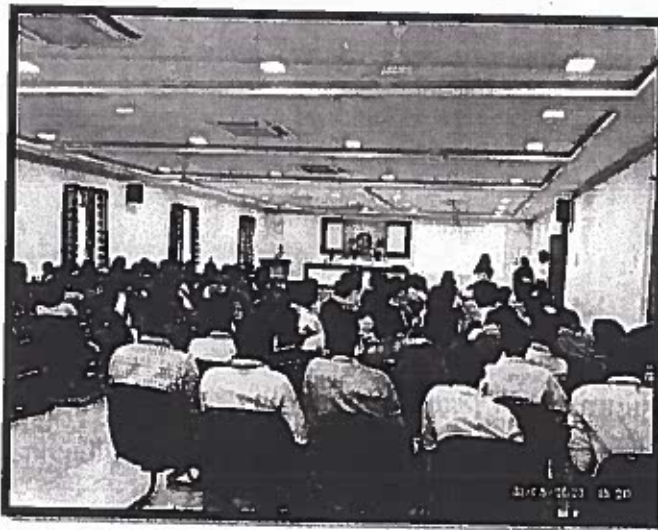


Fig: students & staff participation in world no tobacco day

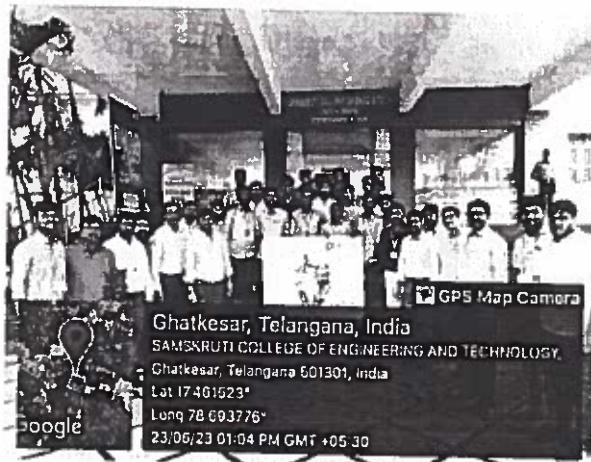


Fig: Student Assembly at college premises

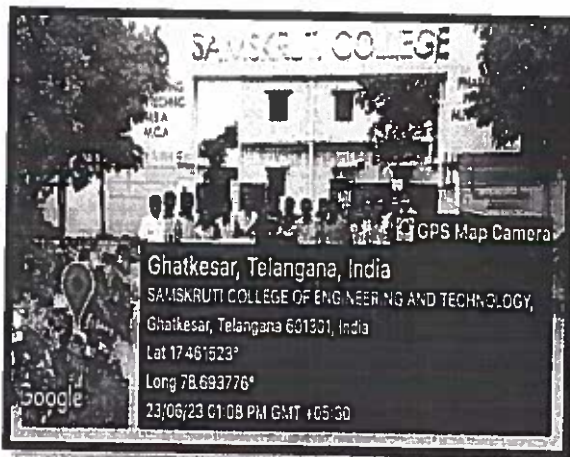


Fig: International Olympic Day relay Starting point & Finishing point Photos

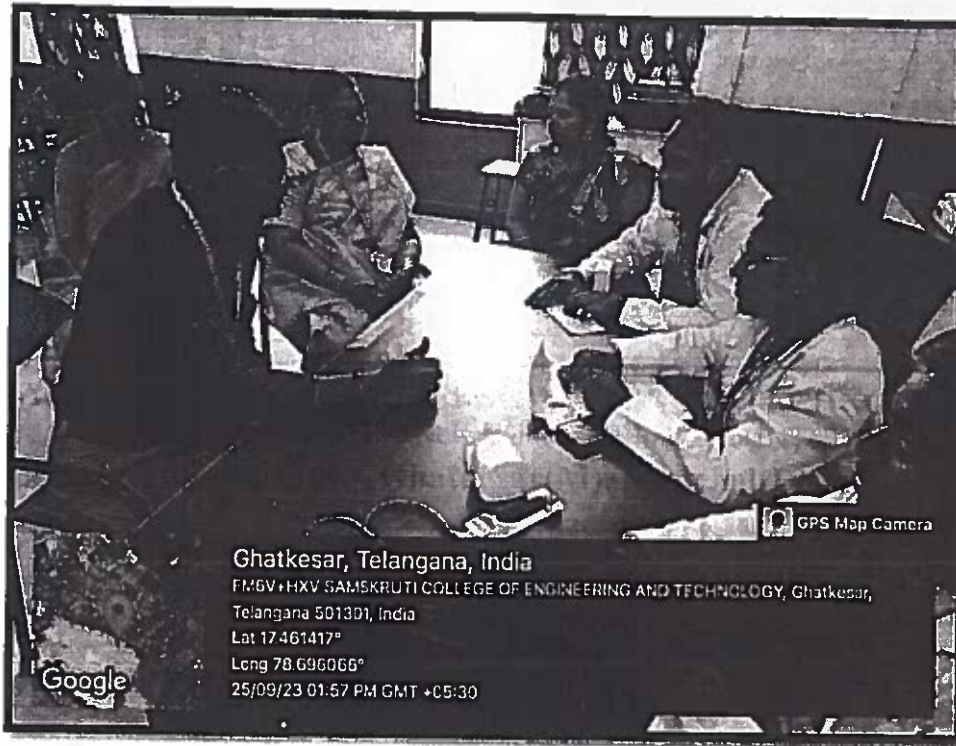

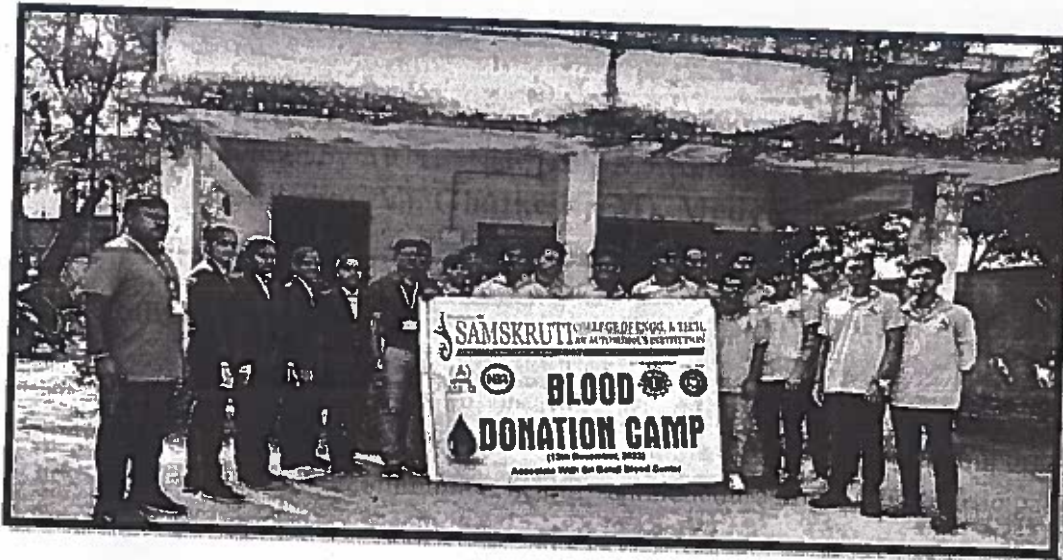


Fig. Awareness Rally in Kondapur village
