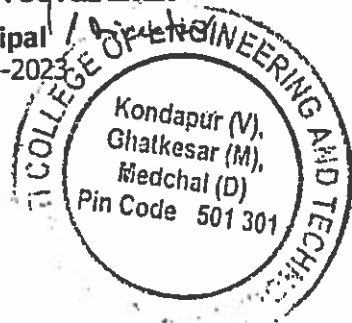

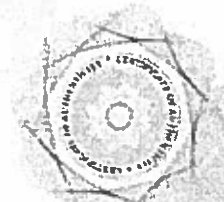

This document constitutes a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) between TNS India Foundation (TNSIF) and Samskruti Collage of Engineering and Technology, Hyderabad.

This MoU is effective from, 13/December/2023, hereinafter mentioned as "Effective Date" by and between Samskruti Collage of Engineering, affiliated to the JNTUH University and hereinafter referred to as "The College", represented by Principal, Dr C. Udaya Kiran .

AND

TNS India Foundation, a charitable organization registered under section 25 of the Companies Act 1956, having PAN number AAECT4021D, and having its registered office at 302, Wellington Business Park 2, Andheri-Kurla Road, Andheri East, Mumbai- 400069, Maharashtra, India, hereinafter referred as "TNSIF", represented by its Managing Director, Rupa Bohra.

## Background

TNS India Foundation (TNSIF), a section 25 Company incorporated under the provision of The Companies Act, 1956 is conducting a "Future Skills Program" for the enhancement of employability and workplace skills for deserving youth.

In this connection, TNSIF intends to be associated and work closely with Ahmedabad Institute of Technology, Ahmedabad to conduct employability training for the final year college students. This will include activities throughout the year. Further, TNSIF will continue to support trained students on placements for 6-10 months post their final examinations

## Facets of the Program:

1. The employability training program includes Technical training, Communication readiness, Interview readiness, Personal Development, Work readiness, and Digital readiness.
2. There is no cost for students to attend the above-mentioned training.
3. Each training batch size will be about 50- 60 students. Students will be required to complete the training provided within a designated period of time.
4. Sessions of duration 2 hours each are to be conducted weekly for each batch by TNSIF.
5. Students will be provided a certificate on successful completion of the course with minimum attendance criteria of 90% (for both in-person and online training).
6. Students will be further supported in job linkages and placements by TNSIF from the time of training completion till they are placed i.e. 6-10 months after their training is complete.
7. College is expected to support the successful training and placements of all students, once they take up this service with TNSIF.

For this purpose, TNSIF requires support of the college in the following areas:

1. Facilitating discussions and engagement with the 4<sup>th</sup> year degree students. This involves the following:
  1. Assistance in student mobilization and batch scheduling with Candidates of <college name>, <city>.
  2. Support in allocating batches (of about 50- 60 students approximately) per faculty member for optimum utilization of resources and training effectiveness.
    - Provide assistance w.r.t. conducting career fests drive and continued student participation.
2. Infrastructure support for the following:
  - o Lecture schedules / slots to conduct the batches

## **Background:**

- 1) Samskruti College of Engineering & Technology, Kondapur (V)-501301, Ghatkesar (M) Medchal Dist (Old R.R. Dist), Hyderabad, Telangana, India is a well-established educational institution providing higher education to a diverse student population in the Telangana region.
- 2) The CSC Academy is delivering various Government of India-sponsored skill and education programs, in addition to courses from private sector. Many of them are funded under Government schemes or under Corporate Social Responsibility.

## **Objective:**

The First Party and the Second Party mutually agree to collaborate on an up-skilling program in the Internet of Things (IoT) technology in collaboration with C-DAC & IEEE for the benefit of SC & ST students pursuing Diploma and Undergraduate courses at Samskruti College of Engineering & Technology, Kondapur (V)-501301, Ghatkesar (M) Medchal Dist (Old R.R. Dist), Hyderabad, Telangana, India.

## **Scope of Collaboration:**

- 1) The Second Party shall provide a comprehensive IoT up-skilling program consisting of two distinct courses:
  - (a) Program 1: Software IoT
  - (b) Program 2: Embedded & Application IoT
- 2) The training program will be conducted virtually, spanning a total duration of 280 hours.
- 3) The Second Party shall ensure that the training enrollment process and training to be conducted free of cost for the selected SC & ST students.

## **Responsibilities:**

- 1) The First Party shall identify all eligible SC & ST students from the college to participate in the up-skilling program and enroll the students.
- 2) The First Party shall provide the necessary infrastructure and support for Enrollment.
- 3) The First Party shall ensure all complete the course.
- 4) The Second Party shall register all the eligible SC & ST students, who are identified by First Party.
- 5) The Second Party shall enroll all the students short-listed and selected by C-DAC / IEEE in any one course mentioned in the scope of collaboration as per the student's choice.
- 6) Upon successful completion of the program, the Second Party shall facilitate the issuance of IEEE-certified certificates to the students.

## **Terms and Conditions:**

- 1) The collaboration period commences on 23.12.2023 and it will be effective for one year which can be extended based on mutual consent and subject to the availability of the scheme.

- 2) Both parties shall maintain the confidentiality of any proprietary information shared during the collaboration.
- 3) Any modifications or amendments to this MoU shall be made in writing and agreed upon by both parties.
- 4) This collaboration is subject to the availability of resources and compliance with both CSC Academy and government regulations.
- 5) Either party may terminate this collaboration by providing written notice at least 30 days prior to the intended termination date.

## Memorandum of Understanding

AND WHEREAS, the Parties seek to collaborate with each other to mutually complement their synergies and to jointly work on building capacity of learners through one or more of the programs managed by Edunet.

NOW THEREFORE, this Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter called "MOU") witnesses the following.

- Term and termination:** This MOU is valid from the Effective Date till 31<sup>st</sup> March 2027. It can be extended by further periods, as agreed to by the Parties in writing from time to time. Either Party may terminate this MOU by giving the other minimum 30 days' notice in writing. The MOU will be deemed terminated at the end of the notice period or after completing all ongoing activities so that the beneficiaries (learners and teachers) are not negatively impacted, whichever is later. Neither party will be liable to pay any compensation to the other party in respect of expiry of term of or termination of this MOU.
- Single Point of Contact (SPOC) for program co-ordination:** Both the Parties shall each appoint a suitable person who will serve as a single point of contact (SPOC) on all matters related to program rollout. Individual learners and teachers may be in touch with corresponding trainers, mentors, advisors, and peers during program rollout, but all matters related to the execution of this MOU shall reside with the SPOC in accordance with the terms as agreed between the parties.
- Program Calendar:** The SPOCs from both Parties will work with their respective internal stakeholders to develop a calendar for the program(s) rollout at the start of every quarter. This calendar will then be synchronized and published for use by everyone.
- Responsibilities of Parties:** The following table outlines the responsibilities of both Edunet and the Institution towards this collaboration.

Online platforms for learning and development

Institution will provide online access, without discrimination, to all program participants.

Online platforms for each of the programs of interest to the Institution will be made available to it. Links for these platforms will be made available to the Institution in a timely manner

Assessment and certification

Institution will ensure that assessments carried onsite or offline are proctored and professionally managed.

Edunet will conduct assessments, as required, for its programs prior to certification by Edunet and/or its partners and sponsors.

Career Services Support

The Institution's placement cell and placement officers shall work in close cooperation with the Edunet Career Services team.

Edunet will provide linkages with local and regional industry, government and the local start-up ecosystem (incubators etc) that will help learners with gainful employment and/or entrepreneurial opportunities. Interactions will be encouraged in terms of classrooms sessions, workshops, internship opportunities, career opportunities and entrepreneurship opportunities.

Fees

Institution will not charge any extra fees from learners for participation in Edunet programs.

Edunet will not charge any fees from the students/institution for the program.

5. **Non-binding nature of this MOU:** The MOU is not binding on either Party, and each is working with the other out of sheer good-will and for the benefit of the learners. Neither this MOU, nor any activities described herein, shall be construed as creating a partnership, joint venture, franchise, agency or other such relationship beyond the scope of the MOU. Neither party is authorised, in any manner, to make any commitment on behalf of or to bind the other party.
6. **Each Party is responsible for its own costs:** Other than costs explicitly identified in this MOU, the Institution and Edunet will independently manage their cost towards fulfilment of obligations under this MOU.

The Parties agree to the terms and conditions set forth above and have caused their duly authorised representatives to sign and execute this MOU on the Effective Date.





This Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU") is effective from the date of signatures below ("Effective Date"); hereinafter, each a "Party" or together, "the Parties". EduSkills will be referred as 'First party' and Samskruti College of Engineering and Technology will be referred as 'Second party'.

The Parties have been discussing a proposed collaboration in the area of "Skill Development, IT Education and Workforce Development Programs" ("Collaboration Areas").

Now the Parties agree as follows:

A. NON-BINDING TERMS.

The Parties understand that MOU is intended only to summarize the current understanding of the parties with respect to the principal terms of the proposed collaboration.

The Parties understand that this MOU is intended only to summarize the current understanding of the Parties with respect to the Collaboration Areas and to facilitate their further discussions regarding certain objectives of the proposed partnership, as more fully described in Exhibit A, which are non-binding on the Parties. The terms and objectives set forth in Exhibit A shall be used for discussion purposes only and shall not be deemed to create any rights or obligations for or on behalf of any Party.

B. BINDING TERMS

The Parties hereby acknowledge and agree that the following subsections under this Section B (Binding Terms) shall be binding and create legal rights and obligations on the Parties.

1. Confidentiality

In this MOU "Confidential Information" means any information or data, irrespective of the form and nature thereof, that is material to the Party disclosing such information ("Discloser") to the other Party ("Recipient"), including, but not limited to technical know-how, specifications, designs, models, software, techniques, drawings, processes, as well as industrial and intellectual property rights, business information, trade secrets, customer lists, financial information, process, costs, sales and marketing plans, information posted on their respective websites or any other information with the Recipient knows or reasonably ought to know is confidential, proprietary or trade secret information of the Discloser.

The Recipient shall at all times, both during the term of this MOU and for a period of at least three (3) years after its expiration or termination, keep in trust and confidence all such Confidential Information, and shall not use such Confidential Information other than for the purpose of fulfilling its obligations under this MOU, nor shall the Recipient disclose any such Confidential Information to any third party without the Disclosing Party's prior written consent. Upon termination of this MOU or written request from the Discloser, the Recipient shall, within fifteen (15) days from such termination or request, return all Confidential Information and any and all copies thereof to the Discloser, or at the Discloser's option, destroy the Confidential Information and any and all copies thereof, and certify such destruction

The obligations of confidentiality set forth herein shall not apply to information which;

- a. Was rightfully in possession of or known to the Recipient without any obligation of confidentiality prior to receiving it from the Discloser;
- b. Is, or subsequently becomes, legally and publicly available without breach of this MOU;
- c. Is rightfully obtained by the Recipient from a source other than the Discloser, without any obligation of confidentiality; or
- d. Is developed by or for the Recipient without use of the Confidential Information.

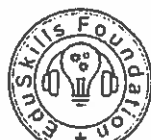
The Recipient may only disclose Confidential Information pursuant to a valid order issued by a court or governmental agency, provided that the Recipient provides the Discloser

- a. Prior written notice of such obligation; and
- b. The opportunity to oppose such disclosure or obtain a protective order.

The Confidential Information shall remain the property of the Discloser and no license to any existing or future intellectual property rights or Confidential Information is granted or implied under this MOU.

All Confidential Information is provided "AS IS". The Discloser shall not be liable for any inaccuracy or completeness of the Confidential Information, nor are there any express or implied representations or

warranties by either party to the other, including with respect to the infringement of any intellectual property rights or any right of privacy, or any rights of third persons.

## 2. Scope

The scope of this MOU does not cover any development work, testing, licensing, distribution, support, sales, or maintenance. Should the Parties decide to pursue such matter that is outside the scope of this MOU, the Parties shall enter into a development, license, distribution, or other appropriate written agreement(s) accordingly.

## 3. Publicity

The Parties hereby agree that no press release or other public announcements regarding this MOU or any agreements contemplated thereby shall be made without prior review and written agreement signed by a duly authorized representative of the other Party.

## 4. Term and Termination

The Parties agree that this MOU shall be effective as of the Effective Date and shall continue in effect until the earliest occurrence of one of the following: (1) the execution of a definitive MOU or definitive agreement relating to the scope of this MOU; (2) written notice by one Party to the other of termination of this MOU; or thirty-six (36) months from the Effective Date of this MOU. Section B (including all subsections) shall survive any termination of this MOU. Upon expiry of the Term, it is the intention of the Parties to further progress the solutions initiated under this MOU towards overall achievement of the objectives and outcomes contemplated herein. Second party shall, to this extent, endeavor to continue maintaining and promoting such solutions and projects to further the objectives set forth in the MOU.

## 5. Limitation of Liability

Except for liability relating to either Party's breach of the other Party's confidential information or intellectual property rights, in no event shall either Party be liable to the other Party for any direct, indirect, incidental, special, punitive or consequential damages or loss of profits, lost revenue or loss of data.

Notwithstanding the foregoing, nothing in this MOU shall limit the Parties liability for bodily injury or death caused by its negligence or its liability in the tort of deceit.

## 6. Intellectual property rights

Each Party will retain the exclusive rights, title and ownership of all its pre-existing Intellectual Property, Confidential Information and materials (including, without limitation, proprietary ideas, sketches, diagrams, text, know-how, concepts, proofs of concepts, artwork, software, algorithms, methods, processes, identifier codes or other technology) owned or developed by such Party.

## 7. Governing laws and jurisdiction

The Parties shall make efforts in good faith to amicably resolve all disputes as may arise out of or in connection with this MOU. This MOU shall be subject to and governed by the laws of India and the Indian courts shall have exclusive jurisdiction over any claim arising under this MOU. Notwithstanding the foregoing, either Party may seek interim injunctive relief in any court of appropriate jurisdiction with respect to any alleged breach of such Party's intellectual property or proprietary rights.

## 8. Costs

Unless otherwise agreed upon in writing, each Party shall bear its own costs and expenses arising in connection with this MOU and the possible negotiations, completion and implementation of definitive Agreements if any, including but not limited to costs of experts, consultants, lawyers and travel expenses.

## 9. Amendment

This MOU may be amended at any time by the mutual written assent of the Parties.



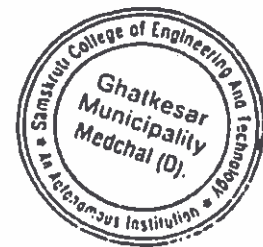
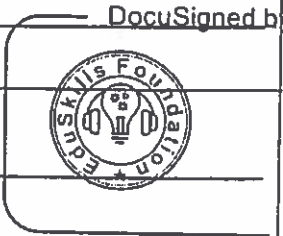


10. Severability


