Samskruti College of Engineering and Technology implements and organizes the special events like national and international commemorative days and instill a sense of meaning and significance in the lives of students and staff. The day makes us to recollect the incredible past moments and cherish the achievements of our founding fathers. Some of the days celebrated in the institute are:

International Yoga Day is celebrated annually on **June 21** to raise awareness about the benefits of practicing yoga and its role in promoting a healthy lifestyle. Proposed by India and endorsed by the United Nations in 2014, the day recognizes yoga as a holistic approach to health and well-being. The date coincides with the **summer solstice**, the longest day of the year in the Northern Hemisphere, symbolizing the connection between nature and human existence.

World Population Day is observed annually on **July 11** to raise awareness about global population issues, including overpopulation, gender equality, family planning, and sustainable development. Established by the United Nations in 1989, the day highlights the impact of rapid population growth on resources, healthcare, education, and the environment. It emphasizes the need for informed decision-making regarding reproductive health and the importance of achieving a balance between population growth and resource availability.

Independence Day commemorates a nation's freedom from colonial rule or foreign domination. In India, it is celebrated annually on **August 15**, marking the day in 1947 when the country gained independence from British rule after nearly 200 years. The day honors the sacrifices of freedom fighters who fought for liberty. Celebrations include flag-hoisting ceremonies, parades, cultural events, and the Prime Minister's address to the nation from the Red Fort.

Teachers' Day is celebrated on **September 5** in India to honor teachers' contributions to education and society. It marks the birth anniversary of **Dr. Sarvepalli Radhakrishnan**, a renowned scholar and India's second President. Students express gratitude through events, performances, and gestures, acknowledging teachers' vital role in shaping their future.

Ganesh Chaturthi is a Hindu festival celebrating the birth of **Lord Ganesha**, the remover of obstacles and the god of wisdom. It involves installing Ganesha idols, offering prayers, and performing rituals over 10 days. The festival concludes with **Ganesh Visarjan**, where idols are immersed in water amid joyful processions and chants.

Every year on 25 September, National Service Scheme Day is observed and celebrated across the country. The Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports conducts and manages the National Service Scheme (NSS), which is a public service program. In the year 1969, the National Service Scheme was introduced on the occasion of the birth centenary of Mahatma Gandhi.

Bathukamma is a vibrant floral festival celebrated by women in **Telangana**, India, during **Navaratri**. Women create flower arrangements in a conical shape, representing Goddess Gauri. They sing, dance, and offer prayers, seeking health, prosperity, and happiness. The festival highlights Telangana's cultural heritage, nature's bounty, and the spirit of community.

Self-defense empowers women and girls to protect themselves from harm. It includes physical techniques, situational awareness, and confidence-building strategies. Learning self-defense fosters independence, reduces fear, and promotes personal safety. It's a vital tool for addressing violence and harassment, enabling women to respond effectively and assertively in threatening situations.

Semi-Christmas is an informal celebration observed halfway to Christmas, typically six months before or after December 25. It's a lighthearted occasion for sharing holiday cheer early, often marked with festive decorations, songs, and gatherings. While not a traditional event, it spreads joy and keeps the Christmas spirit alive year-round.

Sankranti, or **Makar Sankranti**, is a major Hindu harvest festival celebrated in January, marking the sun's transition into **Capricorn (Makara)**. It signifies the end of winter and the start of longer days. Traditions include kite flying, sharing sweets, and rituals expressing gratitude for harvests, celebrated uniquely across India with regional variations.

Republic Day is celebrated in India on **January 26**, marking the adoption of the **Constitution of India** in 1950, which established the country as a sovereign republic. The

breathing techniques (Pranayama) and their benefits in reducing stress and improving concentration.

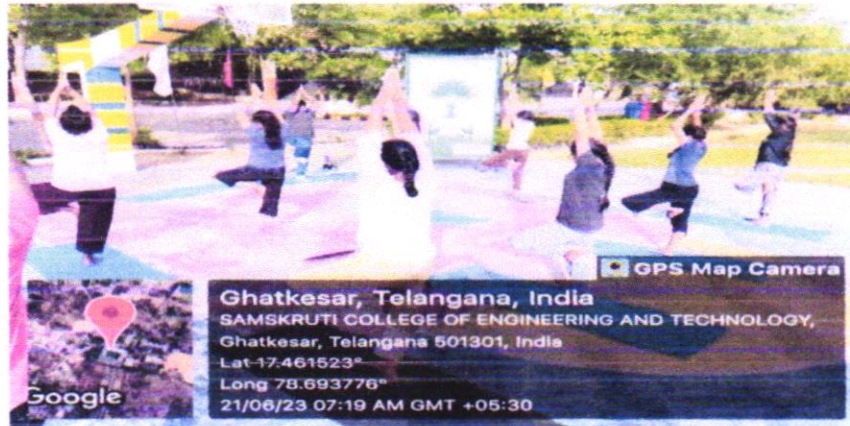


Fig: Surya Namaskar on the Yoga day in the observation of sports in charge (PD)

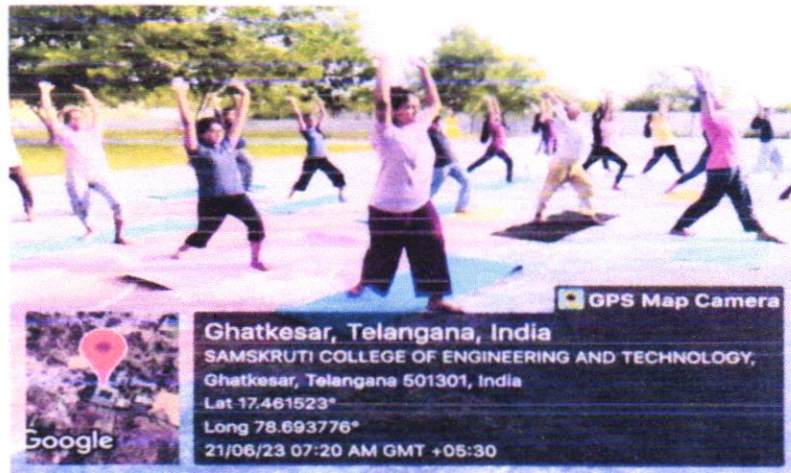


Fig: Students practicing Asanas

 - **Bhujangasana** (Cobra Pose)
 - **Adho Mukha Svanasana** (Downward Dog Pose)
 - **Savasana** (Corpse Pose) for relaxation.
- **Pranayama:** Breathing exercises including **Anulom Vilom** (alternate nostril breathing) and **Kapalbhati** (breath of fire).
- **Guided Meditation:** A short session focusing on mindfulness and calming the mind.

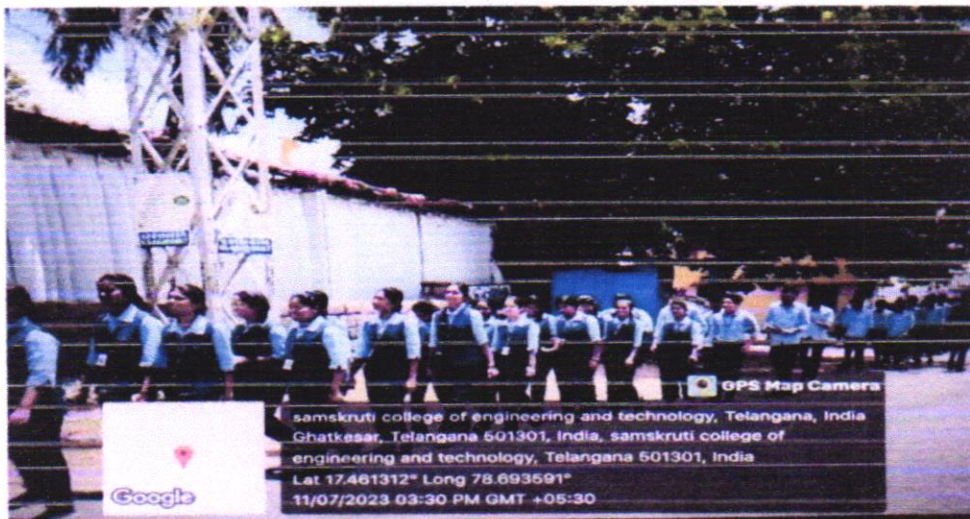

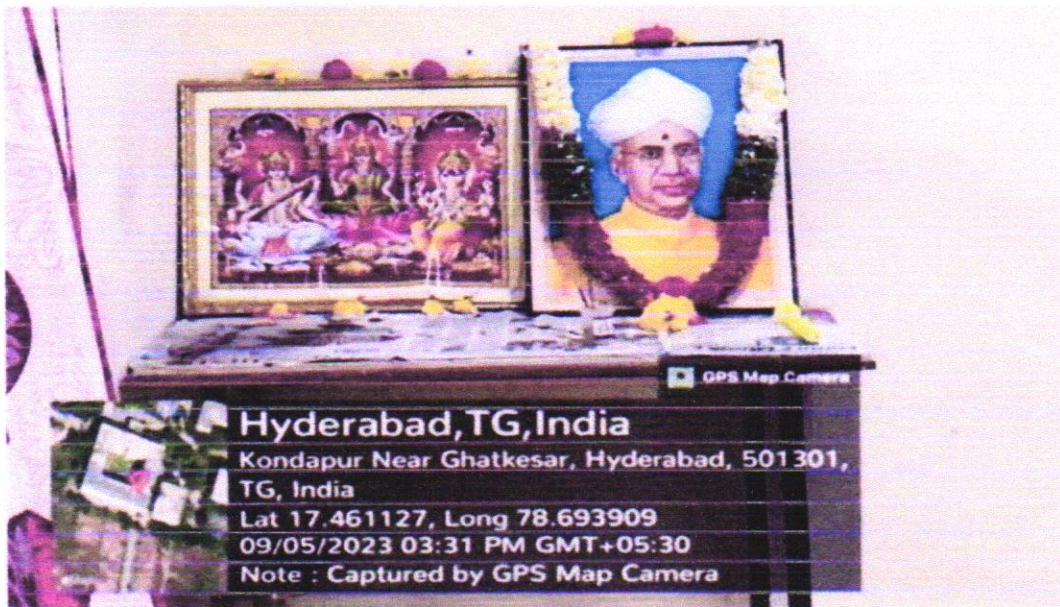


Fig: Sarvepalli Radhakrishna Birth Anniversary

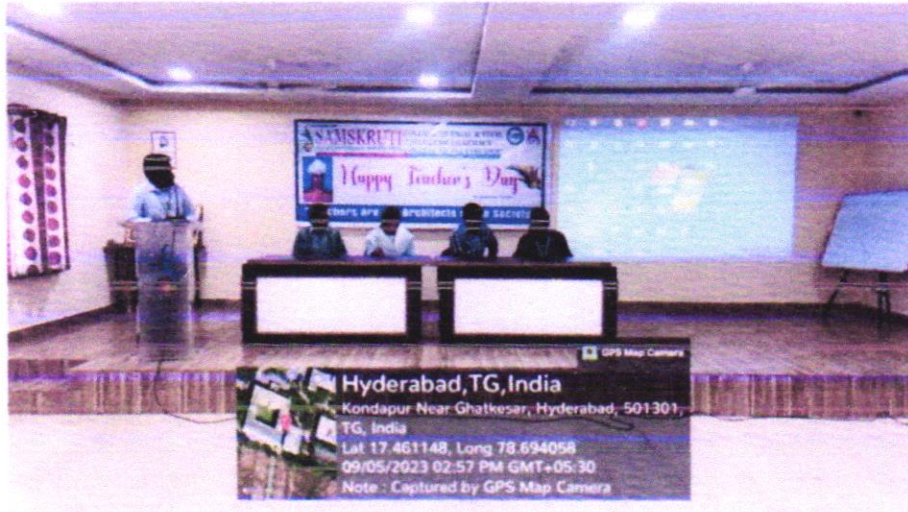


Fig: Inspiring Speech by Faculty in Teachers Day celebration
