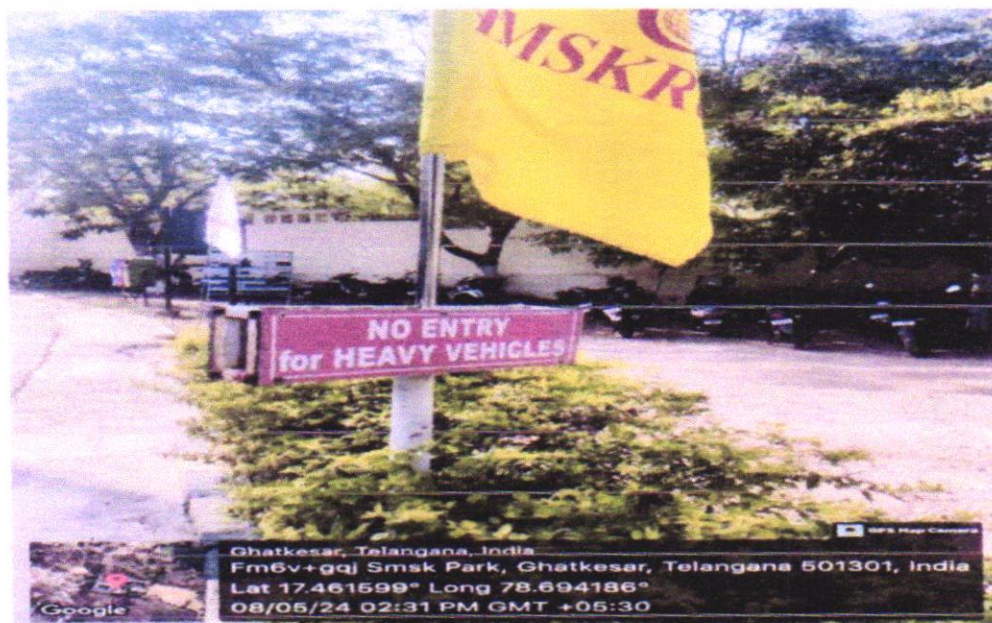

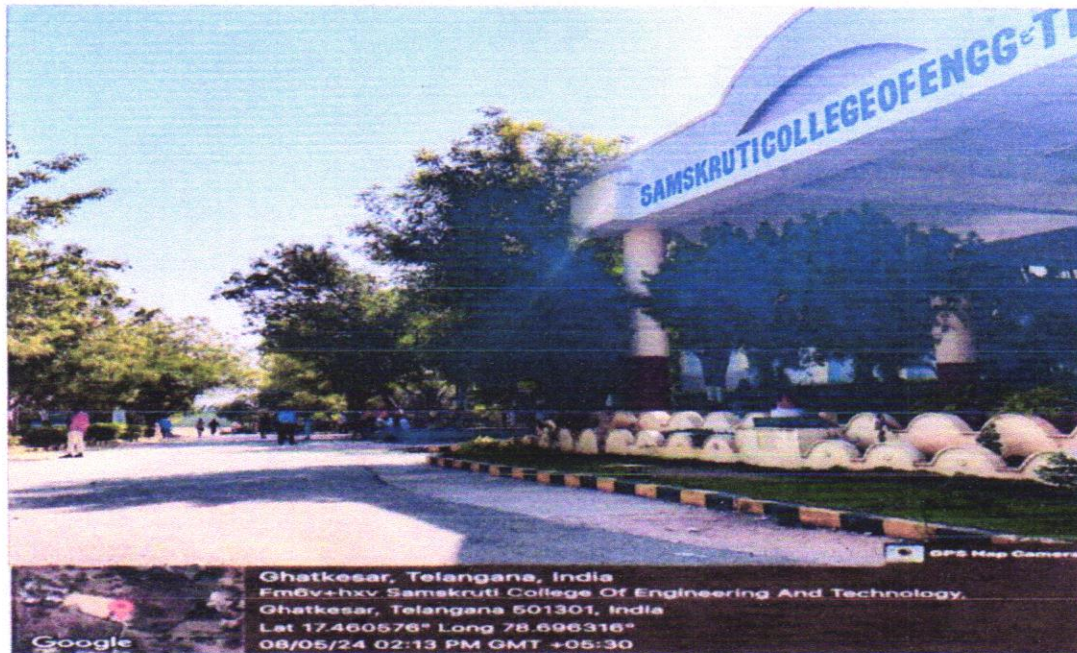
7.1.5.(4) Sign Board for Restricting Usage Of Mobile Phones

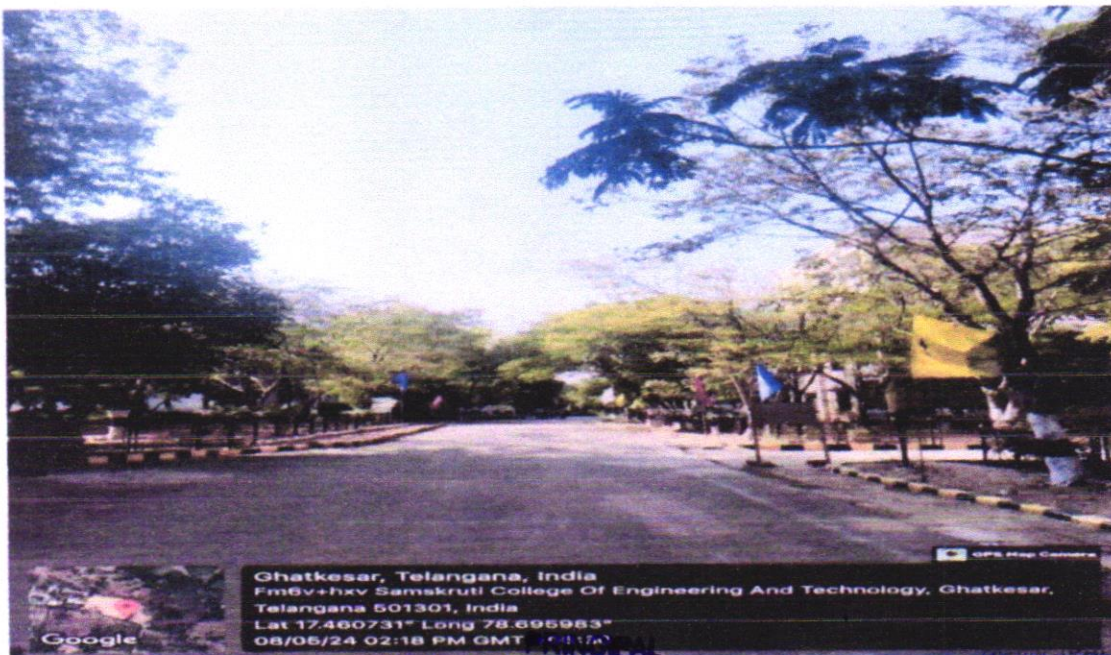

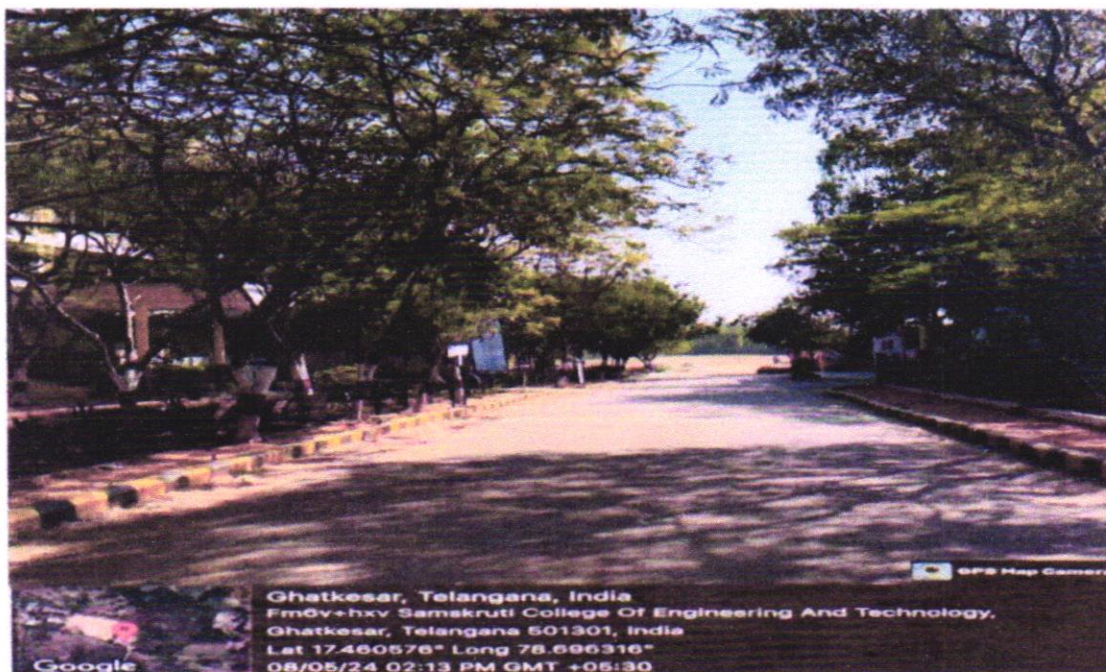
