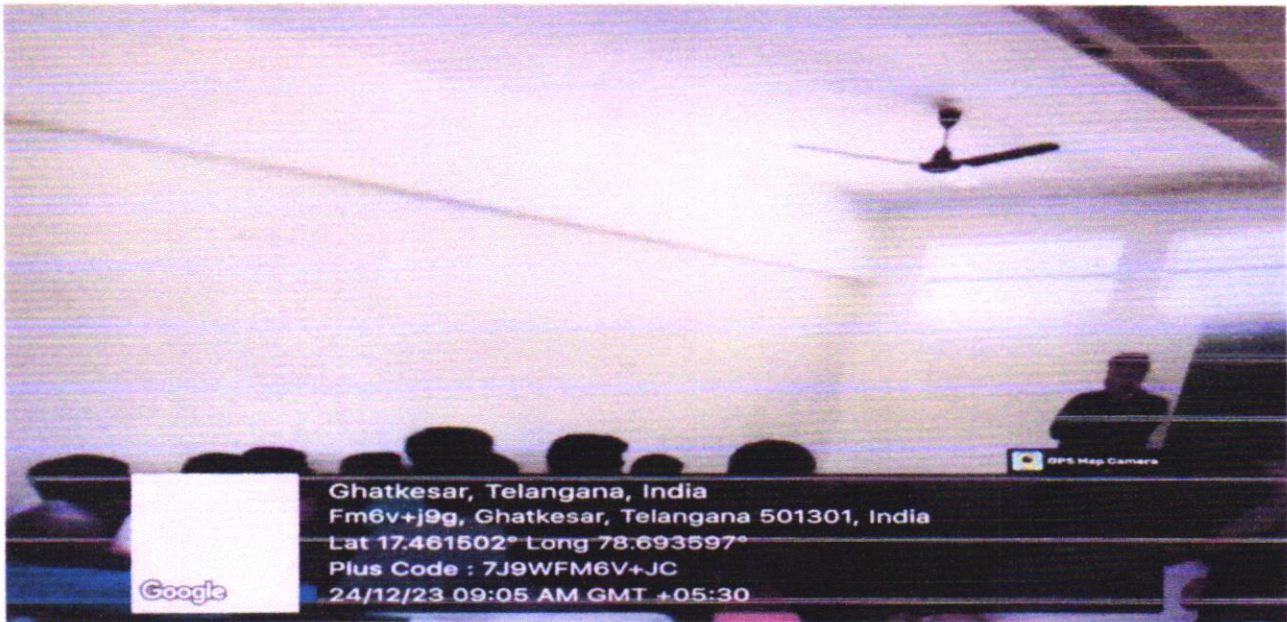
Students Participated: 35members
